

Brick Street Cemetery Inscriptions

The following document is primarily composed of the gravestone inscriptions from historic gravestones at Brick Street Cemetery. While a number of surveys have taken place at the site, conducted by the City of London, TMHC, and the Ontario Genealogical Society, numbering systems have been altogether inconsistent between the surveys over the years. This book aims to provide the complete record of gravestone inscriptions, accompanied by the original numbering system, based on the system developed by Bernard Gill. These numbers break the cemetery into rows, and numbers each stone within the row, beginning at the east side and moving west. At the site, the row numbers are painted in white at the south side of the burial ground on a wood fence. Each row starts at number one nearest to the fence, and moves north, with their numbers consisting of the row number, a colon, and the stone number in that row (eg. 5:03). In some cases, gravestones are not in sequential order, as some gravestones were uncovered after the row has been numbered and surveyed previously. In these cases, the next number in the row has been assigned to the stone, rather than renumbering all stones to retain a sequential order (eg. 2:01, 2:02, 2:17, 2:03, etc.)

The site also includes many auxiliary stones which have been added within the last few years to provide a record of inscriptions for particularly weathered stones or memorialize graves which are otherwise unmarked. We have chosen to number these stones using a different numbering system, so as to differentiate them from the historic gravestones. These stones will be indicated on the record with 'AX' before the row number. Each auxiliary stone will be given a unique stone number that will fall in sequence with other auxiliary stones in the row, listed in order within the row. (eg. 3:1, 3:2, AX3:1, 3:3 etc).

In accordance with international gravestone inscription recording standards, the following indicators will be utilized within this text:

- / will indicate a line break;
- [] will indicate an inscription that is unclear or partially assumed
- Text presented in italics within the inscription is representing italics script on the gravestone. Italics in (...) indicates a comment or note from the writer. Example: (*gravestone is broken at base*).

The majority of these data can also be found online at Find a Grave.com, with many accompanying photos. Stones of particular note have been photographed and included throughout this chapter. As you read through the inscriptions, you might notice poignant epitaphs with poems and verses written to the decedents. Some of these are scriptural texts, but more often the inscription is a memorial verse of a personal nature. The following selection is a sampling of such verses found on the gravestones of children buried in the cemetery.

You may also notice, reflected in these verses, the sensibilities of society in the mid-late 19th century, and their relationships with death and dying. While earlier settler communities such as those on the east coast of North America in the 17th – mid 18th centuries had a more transparent view of mortality, adorning gravestones with stark images of skulls, hour glasses, and coffins, by the late 18th and into the 19th centuries, North American society had adopted what has been

referred to as a ‘softening’ of death. Gone were the skulls, replaced with almost romantic willow trees, Greco-Roman urns, weeping woman, and lambs, among dozens of others.

The adoption of terms like ‘sleeping’ rather than dead, and epitaphs beginning with ‘To the Memory of’ instead of ‘Here lies the body of’ all allow researchers to understand a little better, what a community thought about death and dying as a part of their daily lives. Even today, our societies have changed their relationship with mortality, and it is reflected through the individuality of inscriptions and iconography chosen for contemporary gravestones. Due to high infant mortality rates in the 19th and early 20th centuries, seeing children’s gravestones are not unusual in large numbers. These verses, and the delicate, detailed nature of the stones chosen for them by their grieving families reflect the love they felt for their children, something which has never changed.

“Sleep on sweet babe and take thy rest,
God called thee home, He thought it best.”

“This lovely bud so young and fair,
Called home by early doom,
Just came to show how sweet a flower
In paradise could bloom”

“Short was the little stranger’s stay,
He came but as a guest,
He tasted life and fled away
To his eternal rest.”

“Our darling one hath gone before

Gravestone Transcriptions

The following section includes the transcriptions of every know historic and auxiliary gravestone present at Brick Street Cemetery. The transcriptions and row numbers are correlated between the original records in ‘Bernie’s Book’ and later transcription records collected by the Friends of Brick Street Cemetery. The site consists of approximately 24 rows of gravestones, which are indicated on the fence at the south end of the burial ground.

Preparations for a georeferenced map are underway, and GPS coordinates for each grave marker and plot marker at the site were collected by the Heritage Council of the City of London. At the time of writing, the map is being filled in with the transcription details and photos of the gravestones.
